CYNOR CLASSICS LED BY BOBBY CYNOR RETURN TO MN

On Sunday September 25 we will again have the Cynor Classics Chicago Stlye Honky Polka Band back with us. Honky stlye polka music had its origins in Chicago. The typical honky band will have a clarinet, a trumpet, concertina, drums & bass (& just 1 music stand, sorry I couldn't resist). You have all heard & seen Wanda & Stephanie over the years performing authentic honky stlye polkas. Up here in our area we have a very notable & talented honky stlye polka band in the Cynor Classics. They hail from Sheldon WI. This band is actually the 3rd generation of the Cynor Family Polka Band. Bobby's grandfather had the first band playing in the 60s & 70s. Then Bobby's father took over playing from the 60s to the 80s. The current Cynor Classics band started by Bobby & his brother, Bernie, was

originally a 2-piece band began in 1993, then grew to the current 6-piece band. They have been playing polkas for 30 years! They love their polkas – they believe polka music is happy music – the fans make the bands or as Lil Wally would say, "Live it up, shoot the moon!"

Bobby started playing when he was 7 BUT not concertina! He was a drummer. His favorite band growing up was Lil Wally & when Bobby was 5 he would drum along with Lil Wally with 2 butter knives on top of the long stereo cabinet. His mother said to his dad, "We have to get him some drums – he's ruining our furniture!" It wasn't til later he learned concertina that he plays today. Over the years Bobby has played with some well-known bands & in 2017 he was elected to the World Concertina Congress Hall of Fame. So please take this opportunity to join us in September to welcome the Cynor Classics back to MN


