



The International Polka Association (IPA) held their annual festival as a "Virtual Festival" this past September. The IPA offered an event this year for the first time as part of the festival was a Youngsongwriter's Competition. It was open to "young composers" between the ages of 10 to 35. They could submit a polka or a waltz. It had to be a new song, one that had not been recorded or played on social media. Cash prizes were offered for first & second place winners. There were 21 entries. The top four winners were introduced on the Virtual Festival program.

CONGRATULATIONS to MPA member Nathan Neuman, who was named first place winner with the song "Pass It On" & also placed third as a co-writer of another song. Here is what Nathan shared about the competition & his musical background. He decided to enter because it sounded like a lot of fun! He hadn't heard of a polka writing contest before. It was an opportunity to write songs independently & with other songwriters. Nathan's winning song, "Pass It On," promotes sharing music & instruments through generations. If not for the generosity of his relatives lending him their concertinas, he may never have become a polka musician. Nathan also co-wrote a song, "The Next Step," with Alli Lange from OH, placing third. Nathan said," I feel very honored to receive first place. I have received compliments from musicians worldwide & congratulations from many fans who have supported me along the way.
