The MPA sends love & sympathy to the friends & family of MPA member Peter P. Mrozinski, who passed away on July 9, 2021 just 1 day shy of his 76th birthday. Peter was 1/2 of the famous Mrozinski Brothers Aleatoric Ensemble. Peter & his brother Tom were instrumental in changing the sound of Polish polka



music in MN. The band played from 1971 to 1988. Peter was a self-taught drummer. He drummed with his dad's band, Pete & The Polka Beats. He also drummed with Frank Patuszak & His Polka Pals.

He was the drummer with the Mrozinski Brothers Aleatoric Ensemble for 3 years, when a neck injury prevented continuing. He then was the manager, promotional director & emcee for the next 14 years for the band. Peter ended his full-time drumming with his son Peter's band, The Two-Tones.

From mid 1970 to mid 1980, Peter & Tom hosted a radio show, The Mrozinski Music Hour, on 1010 WMIN.

Peter was a truly gentle man & a gentleman. He will be sorely missed.

FUNTIME POLKA PARTY RADIO SHOW CELEBRATES 5 YEARS!

The Funtime Polka Party radio show, hosted by Patty Chmielewski & Michael Bell, celebrates 5 years! It all began with an idea of sharing their love of polka music, so they produced a 1-hour syndicated weekly radio show. Soon their idea grew & expanded to a 2-hour show all across the nation on 8 staions in only 5 short years.

Polka music is no stranger to Patty. For over 130 years & 6 generations, the Chmielewski family has been synonymous with polka music. Patty is one of the 4th generation & youngest & only daughter of Pat & Florian's 4 children. She was part of her family's popular weekly television show from Duluth, which began in the late 1970's & aired across the US & Canada for 35 years. Patty was 7 when she made her first recording with a song called "I've Got A Polish Boyfriend" that she is most remembered for in her early years. In 2003 Patty was inducted into the Ironworld USA Polka Hall of Fame in Chisholm MN alongside her father Florian. In 2006, she produced her own CD, "Patty &" More" which showcased her talent & energy. She continues to perform several times a month with the family band which she now leads & has managed the last 10 years. Playing alongside her father Florian now age 94 will always be one of her greatest joys.

With their ongoing passion & devotion to polka music, Patty & Michael moved their personalities to the airwaves in May of 2016. They launched their first 1-hour radio show on KBEK 95.5fm in Braham MN & named it "Funtime Polka Party." Soon after it grew in legth & popularity. Now it is a 2-hour show on 8 stations.
